Test will be performed in small dressage arena.. All trot work will be performed rising. The horse should be asked to change though the trot. The quality of the change will be evaluated. Test may be called. Refusals and knock-downs will be penalized as an error of course with appropriate deduction of points. In the case of a rail in the path, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where he stopped. Score will be calculated in percentage.





Maximum height of fences 2'3" Trot work may be done rising or sitting. The horse may do flying changes or change leads though the trot. The quality of the change will be evaluated. Test may be called. Refusals will be penalized as an error of course with appropriate deduction of points. In the case of a knocked-down rail in the path, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where he stopped. Score will be calculated in percentage.
